AS Greek Unseen Prose (Xenophon) Past Paper: 2014 (The Athenians are invited to a meeting with a Persian King)

When the Athenians are defeated by the Persian fleet, they are invited to a meeting with the King's envoy to hear the peace terms of the Persian King.

Tiribazos, the King's envoy, summoned those who wished to sign up to the peace terms which he was bringing from the King. They all came to the meeting.
