ESSAY Categories:

There will be three Competitions:

i.) One for those Aged 11-16 (from year 7 to year 11).

ii.) One for those Aged 17-19 (from year 12 to year 13)

iii.) One for those Aged 19-24 (Year 1-4 on their respective University Course e.g all uk undergraduates).

- Essay Questions can be up to the individual. However: Essays must be on either Ancient Roman or Ancient Greek history, philosophy, art or literature.
- This is a very varied, and wide range and we look forward to your submissions!
Here are some suggestions:

i.) Roman copies of Greek Art and Sculpture are simply lesser, than their famed Greek counterparts: Discuss.

ii.) Why was there a rebirth of Stoicism in the 1st century AD?

iii.) Why was the Sicilian Expedition such a disaster, for the Athenians?

iv.) What makes a piece of literature, an Epic?

v.) Discuss the dichotomy of power between the Ancient Greek Gods and moira (fate).
You by all means do not have to select one of these. These are just suggestions.

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

- All essay must be submitted in word (.docx) form
- Be within 2,000 word limit
- Contain a bibliography
- Must only contain initials in header for anonymous marking/ review
- Be submitted with a cover sheet to admin@studyclassics.co.uk
- Be submitted by September 1st.
- Must be living and studying in the UK.
